**Secretary/Treasurer's Report:** The Financial Report was submitted by Greg Thorpe. Mason made a motion to approve, second by Anderson. A voice vote was taken, motion carried. **Committee Reports:** Education- Buck gave an update on upcoming training sessions, as always looking for help and ideas. Unified Code Adoption Committee- Lots of progress, IPMC, IBC, IEBC completed, NEC & IRC is still a work in progress but getting closer. There has been discussion on R305.1 and changes. The State of Iowa has a proposed amendment on R313, Sprinklers to delay adoption until Jan 1, 2013, this could affect us. Trying to create handouts to describe confusing sections, a couple samples were passed around. Still looking for volunteers to help create more handouts.

**Old Business:** There was discussion about the ICC Annual conference in Baltimore, Thorpe and Nees will be going from the chapter. Neale informed people to be aware of voting status and proposed changes that will be voted on. Ayers thanked everyone who volunteered at the QCCA Woodworking & Remodeling show. Ayers discussed the IECC compliance stickers and if we should supply them. We need to get quotes and will discuss further next month. Feedback on the steak fry at Sunset Marina was positive. Good steaks and turnout.

**New Business:** Bob Neale gave a legislative update and what has been going on in both Iowa and Illinois. ICC would like the State of Illinois to abandon their code and use chapter 11 of the IBC. The group was in support. Both States have adopted the IECC. Mike Galliard from Mid

American Energy was present to discuss policy changes when gas and electric meters have been shutoff to mobile homes and residences. The group decided to close the regular business meeting to discuss this at length, a motion to adjourn was made by Crowe and second by Nees. A voice vote was taken, motion carried. Meeting adjourned by President Ayers at 12:38 PM.
