Minutes of November 15, 2012 Jumer's- Rock Island, IL

Call to order: 12:14 PM by President Buck.

Treasurer's Report: Joe Kuhlenbeck submitted the October financial report via email.

Education Committee Report: December class on 2012 Significant Changes to IBC- more info to come.

Unified Code Adoption Committee: last met on 11/14/12; done with the Significant Changes to IRC.

Old Business: Introduction of members and guests. Julie Awkerman of QCHBA spoke about the Home Show, February 8-10, 2013. An email request for volunteers for the ILLOWA booth was sent by Autumn Rohwer. Bob Buker and Bob Buck spoke about getting all local jurisdictions involved with the inspection sticker discussion. Bob Buck is still working on getting sprinkler estimates to present to the group for discussion of new codes. Rick Mills and Bruce Crowe unable to attend ICCA on November 8 and did not have the minutes to present.

New Business: Greg Thorpe discussed the IRC benefit class which had 32 people in attendance and the extra books he had for sale on the 2012 Significant Changes. January meeting will have a Simpson Strongtie Presentation for 3 hours. Tom Ayers passed out applications for a free ATC-20 FEMA courses offered for earthquakes and natural disasters. Tim Delathower's new ICC certification was announced to the group as a certified building inspector. The Home Show handouts of highlighters were approved by unanimous vote.

Open Discussion: Tom Ayers spoke about the NFPA-101 from the State Fire Marshalls Office and what 2012 codes are being pushed without a letter protecting existing structures. Todd Robertson spoke about the 2012 IECC codes and that Springfield is moving talks up to 12/5/12. The Attorney General will enforce the statute and JCAR is looking into particulars. Jim Chapman and Tom Ayers talked about their trip to Portland ICC hearings. There will be a new CB access online so that you can vote offsite after viewing the final action hearings. Tom Ayers will get this link for the members. Note: four board members were elected from central USA this term.
