- **ICCA - Greg Thorpe**
 - New Illinois Energy Code has an effective date of May 1st, 2019.
 - There is an amendment to a bill that would adopt Appendix A for solar ready construction. This was put in last minute and did not get discussed. ICCA is opposed to this provision.
 - ICCA has been opposing and fighting hard against the McSweeney Bill.
 - Plumbing code changes are going to 2nd reading/hearing any changes will need to pass this before continuing.
- **QCBR –**
 - Joe Kuhlenbeck gave an overview of the HOT Expo hosted by QCBR.
 - Ray Nees was a presenter at the expo, discussing the role of the Building Inspection Office as a partner in the building industry.
 - Greg Thorpe and myself help by chaperoning a group of students in the morning and afternoon as they made their way from station to station.
 - In total there were 10 vendor/trades presentations for each group to attend.
 - Over 300 8th Grade students attended the Expo from schools all around the Quad City area.
