We agreed as a group to continue these meetings on a weekly basis for a time to cover all changes to the 2012 IRC and IBC. Our next meeting will be on September 12 (Wed) from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. at the Rock Island County Building, Room 320.

Some Notes and Topics discussed:

- Meeting Started at 10:12 a.m. with 8 members present.
- Tom Ayers opened discussion on current pending legislation on sprinklers, State Fire Marshalls Groups' actions, the NFPA 101 Life and Safety Code Adoption and 5000 codes. A discussion ensued about sprinkler adoption and NFPA 101 requirements for commercial and residential rated structures. Tom Ayers made the suggestion for ILLOWA to make up a 2012 guideline handout for sprinkler requirements and / or alternatives for contractors, home builder groups, and home-owners.
- Bruce Crowe revisited the topic of "storable pools" and it's definition. Bruce Crowe would like to further discuss this topic and definition at a later time along with grounding requirements for storable above ground pools.
- Discussion over 2012 IRC changes chapters 1 zoning requirements and 2 definitions and Appendix F; with chapter 3 just started (we will begin with Ch. 3, R302 next meeting); table R301.2(1) still under discussion.
